### **HOSPICE DOCUMENTATION: PAINTING THE PICTURE OF THE ...**

DOCUMENTATION OF APPETITE Appetite usually is a good indicator of decline in a hospice patient Avoid documentation of good, fair or poor appetite This cannot be measured Instead give the number of meals that the patient ate per day along with the % of intake of each meal Get down to even describing the meal provided in

### **Hospice Clinical Documentation**

Hospice Coverage • Clinical documentation requirement for hospice coverage: - Patient record must support documentation in technical elements • Terminal prognosis of 6 months or less • LCD criteria - Days in any billing period without corresponding documentation showing eligibility are unpaid

What Should Your Hospice Do? •Review GIP documentation -Details on the reasons for the change in level of care -Documentation daily -Physician or NP visit documented and billed daily -Documentation is consistent regardless of location of GIP -Physician or NP visits standard practice EVERY DAY of GIP •Review billing practices

### **LifePath Hospice Inpatient Unit Overview**

•Documentation of the skilled need or problem necessitating IPU admission •Documentation that, together, the caregiver and the hospice cannot provide the necessary care plan in the patient's home •GIP following a hospital stay must include documentation why the care cannot be provided in the home at the time of hospital discharge
